I am using "40 Days with Jesus: Celebrating His Presence" as a source for my daily devotion. Sarah Young, its author, has written as if Jesus is speaking to us personally. I am finding it helpful in deepening my relationship with God in Jesus Christ. I share one of her daily devotion for this week:
